\*\*\*20-30 strong volunteers to help load/ unload a truck with flea market items, and to set up/take down approx. 120 heavy wooden banquet tables. Volunteers are needed for approx. 4 hours on Friday, May 25th, and 4 hours on Saturday, May 26th. There will be a coordinator supervising volunteers and providing instruction. This will take place at Gorsebrook School on South Street.

\*\*\*20-30 volunteers ages 14 and up to run simple children's games, collect tickets, and give prizes outdoors in the IWK Playgarden on Saturday, May 26th between 10am-3pm. Volunteers would need to commit to at least one 2-hour shift.


